Important information regarding your visit at
L'Oustalado, please read before using pool

Swimming Pool:

The pool is checked\maintained once per week, the pool technician has a key for the back gate and the pool equipment cupboard, he will not ring the bell so please do not be alarmed if you see someone in the garden! There may also on occasions be a gardener working in the garden.

We have recently installed a pool shelter (Abri), this helps to keep the heat in and other debris out, it also helps maintain the chemical balance of the pool water. It is French law that the pool is covered when left unattended.

We have had a pool heater installed as the pool temperature in the early and late part of the season can be quite "fresh", the pool heater should keep the pool at a comfortable 26-27°C, because of the pool losing most of its heat overnight we do ask that you keep the pool covered at night and when you are not using it (this also helps keep debris out of the pool!)

We have also bought a pool cleaning robot for the pool as the pool can collect some debris in between the weekly cleanings, this is no problem and should not stop you using the pool but if you wish to use it the robot will clean the majority of the pool in about 2 hours, there are instructions on how to use this further down.

There is a pool cleaning net next to the pool should you wish to remove any floating debris from the pool. Some debris does collect at the bottom of the pool between cleanings, this is nothing to worry about and should not stop you from using it!

The switch for the pool light is in the shed to the right of the door, if you use this please remember to switch it off after use.

It is the responsibility of the renter to ensure that the pool is kept covered whenever there is any risk of anyone being in danger of drowning.

The pool Abri should be closed when you arrive at the property, there are fasteners keeping it in position to the front and rear of the Abri on the side nearest the wall, please keep these in place when you are not using the pool as the Abri can be blown open or closed when it is windy.

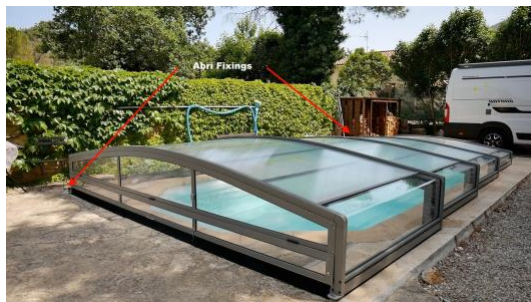
Could you please ensure that the pool is left covered when you go out and when you vacate the property at the end of your stay.

Pool Abri:

To open the Abri simply remove the front fixing and place to one side, the Abri can then be slid back to the desired position, before sliding the Abri back it is a good idea to open the flap at the front of the Abri to give more clearance.



The Abri can then be slid back.....



To close the Abri simply slide back into position and replace the fixing(s)

The Abri can be opened partially, fully or moved completely off the pool by removing the rear fixing, it can also be opened to enter the pool and closed when you are in the pool, this can be good if the weather is inclement but is also very relaxing and tranquil when the weather is good! When moving the Abri off the pool please keep it secured by placing on of the fixings on the other side of the Abri, this stops it being blown forward when there is any wind, (we know from experience that it can blow all the way to other end of the pool at quite a speed!)



When closing the Abri simply slide closed, replace the rear fixing if you have open the Abri all the way off the pool, replace the front fixing and closed the Abri Door.



Pool Cleaning Robot:

The pool cleaning robot is very simple to use, you simply place it in the pool where it sinks to the bottom of the pool, pass the cable through the hole in the shed wall, plug the cable into the power supply in the shed and press the button on the power supply to turn it on!

When the robot has finished its cleaning cycle (approx. 2 hours), pull the robot **GENTLY** to the surface of the pool using its power cable then as soon as it is near the surface take it out of the pool using the handle, please **do not pull it out of the pool using the cable!** When it is out of the pool take out the filter (see picture) to remove the debris and replace in the robot, the robot can then be unplugged and stored in its box in the shed until next needed.

The robot does not manage the steps very well but if there is any debris on the steps this can be brushed to the bottom of the pool (brush on wall next to pool) where the robot should be able to collect it, it occasionally gets stuck on the steps and stops doing anything, if this happens turning the power off, waiting about a minute and turning back on seems to sort this out.

If you wish to use the pool before the cleaning cycle is finished simply turn off the power and remove from the pool.

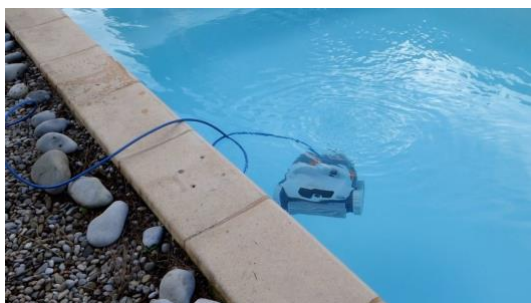
Collect the pool robot from the shed and carefully remove it and its power cable from the plastic container.



Gently unroll the cable and place the robot into the pool



After the robot has sunk to the bottom of the pool pass the cable through the hole in the shed



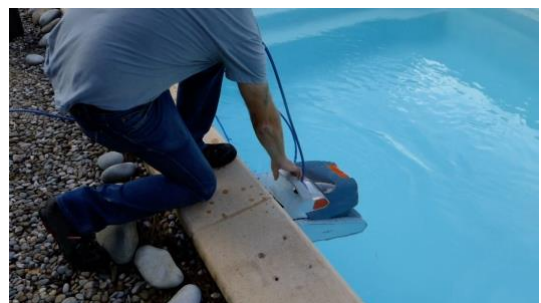
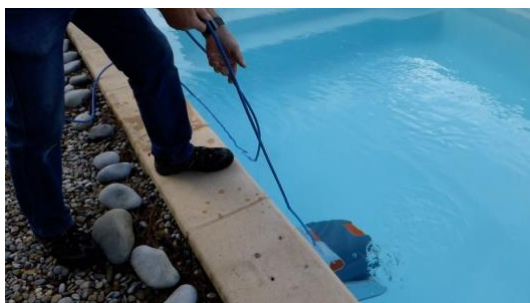
Plug the cable into the power supply and press the power button



The cleaning cycle takes around 2 hours to complete, when finished the power can be turned off and the cable removed from the power supply



The robot can then be pulled gently to the surface using the cable and removed from the water **using the handle**



Allow the water to drain from the robot then remove the debris basket



Clean any debris from the basket with the hose and replace.



The robot can then be placed in its plastic container and the cable carefully wound round avoiding any kinks
